Topic of Presentation:

Different diagnostic approaches to endometriosis, superficial peritoneal endometriosis, and deep infiltrating endometriosis, including the advanced imaging procedures and clinical investigations

Outline

There is the need for an accurate ultrasonographic evaluation and definition of the severity of endometriosis. A detailed routine exam for the sonographic evaluation of endometriosis is mandatory and could be easily implemented in clinical practice. A standardized transvaginal approach and proper sonographer training are both essential for a correct diagnosis. Women with small lesions on ultrasonography could present with severe symptoms or infertility, whereas other women could be asymptomatic. The next goal will be to evaluate the severity of endometriotic lesions staged by transvaginal ultrasonographic evaluation with the severity of clinical symptoms to choose the best clinical and individualized therapeutic approach.
