Dr. Anthony Kayiira is very passionate about endometriosis care. He completed a degree in medicine and surgery at Makerere university college of health sciences. This was followed by a master's degree in obstetrics and gynecology at Uganda Martyr's University Nkozi. He eventually moved to the University of Oxford in the UK and under the supervision of Dr Kevin Coward (known for his work on oocyte activation) and Professor Christian M. Becker (known for his work on endometriosis), completed a master's in clinical embryology with a distinction. He was awarded the prestigious achievement in biosciences prize (Oxford University Press). He moved back to Uganda in 2018 and is currently a clinical embryologist and reproductive medicine specialist at Lifesure fertility and gynecology center.

Dr. Anthony heads the reproductive endocrinology and menstrual health unit at St Francis hospital Nsambya. He also serves as a lecturer for reproductive endocrinology and developmental biology at Uganda martyr's University postgraduate medical school Nkozi. He is a member of the European society of human reproduction and embryology (ESHRE) and a founding member of the Uganda fertility society (UFS).
